The following draft Rules which the Government of Goa proposes to make in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (1) and (2) of section 101 of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (Central Act No. 49 of 2016) so as to further amend the Goa Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, 2018 are hereby pre-published as required by sub-section (1) of section 101 of the said Act, for information of all the persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said draft Rules will be taken into consideration by the Government after expiry of period of 15 days from the date of publication of this Notification in the Official Gazette.

All objections and/or suggestions to the said draft Rules may be forwarded to the Department for Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Porvorim-Goa before the expiry of the said period of 15 days so that they may be taken into consideration at the time of finalization of the said draft Rules.

**DRAFT RULES**

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (1) and (2) of section 101 of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (Central Act No. 49 of 2016) and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Government of Goa hereby makes the following rules so as to further amend the Goa Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, 2018, namely:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Goa Rights of Persons with Disabilities (Second Amendment) Rules, 2024.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their final publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Amendment of rule 3.*— In the Goa Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, 2018

(hereinafter referred to as the “principal Rules”), in rule 3, in sub-rule (1), in clause (iv), for the expression “The Director, Directorate of Social Welfare”, the expression “The Director, Department for Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities” shall be substituted.

3. *Amendment of rule 4.*— In the principal Rules, in rule 4,—

(i) in sub-rule (3), for the words “Directorate of Social Welfare”, the words “Department for Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities” shall be substituted;

(ii) in sub-rule (4), for the words “Assistant Director of Directorate of Social Welfare dealing with Empowerment or Persons with Disabilities”, the expression “Official not below the rank of Assistant Director, Department for Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities” shall be substituted.

4. *Amendment of rule 14.*— In the principal Rules, in rule 14, in clause (viii), for the words “Assistant Director of the Directorate of Social Welfare dealing with empowerment of persons with disabilities”, the expression “Official not below the rank of Assistant Director, Department for Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities” shall be substituted.

5. *Amendment of rule 25.*— In the principal Rules, in rule 25, in sub-rule (1),—

(i) in clause (a), for the expression “Secretary (Social Welfare)”, the expression “Secretary (Department for Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities)” shall be substituted;

(ii) in clause (f), for the words “Director of Social Welfare”, the words “Director of Department for Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities” shall be substituted.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, and in supersession of the existing recruitment rules for the post of Police Sub-Inspector, published vide Government Notification No. 1/5/2013-PER dated 18-09-2013, in the Official Gazette, Series I No. 27 dated 03-10-2013, the Governor of Goa hereby makes the following rules to regulate the recruitment to the Group 'C', Non-Gazetted, Non-Ministerial post, in the Office of the Director General of Police, Government of Goa, namely:—

1. *Short title, application and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Government of Goa, Office of the Director General of Police, Group 'C', Non-Gazetted, Non-Ministerial post, Recruitment Rules, 2024.

(2) They shall apply to the post specified in column (1) of the Schedule to these rules (hereinafter called as the "said Schedule").

(3) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Number, classification and level in the pay matrix.*— The number of posts, classification of the said post and level in the pay matrix attached thereof shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule:

Provided that the Government may vary the number of posts as specified in column (2) of the said Schedule from time to time subject to exigencies of work.

3. *Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.*— The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. *Disqualification.*— No person who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living or who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the service:

Provided that the Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. *Power to relax.*— Where, the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. *Saving.*— Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in that regard.
